What is firefighternearmiss.com?

The National Fire Fighter Near-Miss Reporting System is a voluntary, confidential, non-punitive and secure Web-based reporting system with the goal of improving firefighter safety. By collecting and analyzing information on near-miss events, we can improve command, operations, education and training to reduce the number of firefighter injuries and fatalities.

What is a near-miss event?

A near-miss event is an unintentional, unsafe occurrence that could have resulted in an injury, fatality or property damage. Only a fortunate break in the chain of events prevented an injury, fatality or damage. Situations that qualify as near misses are essentially in the eyes of the reporter. If you are involved in or witness an event you believe is a near miss, then you are encouraged to submit a report at www.firefighternearmiss.com.
