IAFF SPONSORED SCHOLARSHIPS

- The **W. H. (Howie) McClennan Scholarship** is presented to sons, daughters or legally adopted children of fire fighters who were IAFF members in good standing and died in the line of duty. Applications are due February 1st.
- The **Harvard University Trade Union Program Scholarship** provides IAFF members the opportunity to explore key issues of the labor movement. Scholarships are awarded annually to two IAFF members to attend this program. Award is \$1,000 plus tuition. Applications are due July 1st.
- The **Labour College of Canada Intensive Program** provides IAFF members the opportunity to attend the Labour College of Canada Intensive Program in Ottawa. Award is \$1,000 plus tuition. Applications are due July 1st.
- The **National Labor College Scholarship** provides a semester of courses for IAFF members at the National Labor College (NLC) in Silver Spring, Maryland. Scholarships are awarded annually. Award is \$1,000 plus tuition. Applications are due July 1st.
