National Labor College Scholarship

The International Association of Fire Fighters annually awards scholarship funds for three (3) IAFF members to attend the National Labor College.

Amount of Scholarship

The National Labor College Scholarship Award will cover tuition for one semester program consisting of up to three courses (for a total of nine academic credits), room and board, and provide \$1,000 for travel and incidental expenses

Eligibility:

Any IAFF member in good standing with an IAFF Local Affiliate.

Basis of Awards:

Applicants must be an active member of the IAFF Local Affiliate and have demonstrated active participation within the IAFF Local Affiliate as an officer, committee member, etc.

Applicants must also prepare a short statement (about 500 words) on one of the following:

- Your personal interest in attending the National Labor College.
- What do you consider to be the major problems facing the labor movement in the United States today?
- What do you consider to be the major problems facing the fire fighter in the labor union movement today?
