

# IAFF 2010 CONVENTION INFORMATION

## IMPORTANT DATES TO REMEMBER

March 31, 2010	Per capita tax cutoff date for twelve months to be used in determining delegate voting strength. (April 1, 2009 - March 31, 2010, 12-month average per capita payment.) All per capita and EDF loan payments must be paid through this date before credentials can be mailed.
April 1, 2010	The IAFF begins sending credentials, hotel room reservation forms, etc. to locals who have paid March 2010 per capita. Credentials will be sent weekly when March per capita is received.
June 1, 2010	The <b>DEADLINE</b> for receipt of credentials for committee appointments.
June 25, 2010	The <b>DEADLINE</b> for receipt of draft resolutions seeking to censure, condemn or otherwise criticize any person, including fire department personnel, for review by the General President.
July 2010	Per capita tax and EDF loans must be paid through the month of July 2010 to seat delegates at the Convention.
July 6, 2010	The <b>DEADLINE</b> for receipt of all resolutions in the IAFF office by 5 p.m. EDT (50 days preceding convention). Copies of resolutions may be faxed or emailed by July 6, 2010; however, the signed, original resolution must be received by 5 p.m. EDT, Thursday, July 15, 2010 (40 days preceding convention). Any resolution received by mail, including any overnight mail service, after 5 p.m. EDT, on July 6, 2010, that has not previously been received by fax or email will be returned to sender.
July 15, 2010	The <b>DEADLINE</b> for submission of resolutions that have been previously faxed or emailed.
July 16, 2010	The <b>DEADLINE</b> for receipt of proxy and alternate proxy credentials to the IAFF office by 5 p.m., EDT. Any proxy or alternate proxy credentials received after this date and time <u>must have a certified or registered mail postmark from a U.S. or Canadian post office as of July 16, 2010.</u> (NOTE: Express mail, or other overnight mail received after 5 p.m. EDT, July 16, 2010, cannot be accepted.)
July 16, 2010	The <b>DEADLINE</b> for sending credentials with advanced payment for registration to IAFF office. After this date, payment must be made at convention.
July 21, 2010	The cutoff date for hotel room reservations. After this date, reservations will be accepted on room available basis only.
August 2010	Per capita tax payment and EDF loan payments must be received for the MONTH of July 2010 to seat delegates at convention.
August 18, 2010	Executive Board Meeting: Hilton San Diego Bayfront.
August 18, 2010	The following early committees arrive: Credentials, Constitution and By-Laws, Policy, and Resolutions.
August 19, 2010	Credentials, Constitution and By-Laws, Policy, and Resolutions Committees meet at the San Diego Convention Center.
August 21, 2010	The following early committees arrive: Rules-of-Order, Sergeant-at-Arms, Grievances and Appeals, and Legislative.
August 21, 2010	Convention registration begins at noon until 5 p.m. at the San Diego Convention Center.
August 22, 2010	Convention registration continues from 10 a.m. until 5 p.m. Rules-of-Order and Sergeant-at-Arms Committees meet at the San Diego Convention Center.
August 23, 2010	Registration continues from 8 a.m. until 5 p.m. The <b>DEADLINE</b> for picking up delegate or alternate name badge to be seated at convention is 5 p.m. This includes all delegates and alternates, pre-registered and advanced payment, as well as, onsite registration and payment.
August 23, 2010	Opening Ceremony starts at 9 a.m. General Session begins at 1:30 p.m. in the San Diego Convention Center Hall F/G.
August 24, 2010	FIREPAC Leadership Trust Reception at the Hilton San Diego Bayfront, time TBA.
August 26, 2010	General President's Cocktail Reception 6-8 p.m. in San Diego Convention Center Foyer of Hall F/G and the General President's Show 8-10 p.m. in Hall F/G.
August 27, 2010	Convention ends.
