The City Firefighters have organized a ride for Saturday, August 16th 2008. There will be a donation request of \$15 per bike and \$10 per passenger. Registration will be from 10:00 am to 11:00 am at the Butler Fire Department located at 110 N. Washington St. in Butler, PA. The ride will consist of a 3 to 3 ½ hour loop including several stops. The ride concludes at Butler Memorial Park with a cookout.

We ask that riders obey all traffic laws and please have a full tank of gas at the beginning of the ride. Participants must sign a liability waiver during registration the day of the ride.
