Workshop Agenda

- Learn how to use a Self Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA), essential to breathing in heavy smoke.
- During the Fire Ground Orientation, participants will learn to battle a fire with the close supervision of professional fire fighters.
- Participants will also develop the skills to rescue "trapped victims" in the search and rescue maze.
- In the ladder evolution for highrise rescue phase, participants can expect to experience how taller buildings can create obstacles for fire fighters.
- Fire fighters will also teach you how to handle the expected events, such as flashovers.

Transportation: From the Paris Hotel, site of the IAFF EMS Conference, report to the registration area on the Casino level (Registration Desk A, B) by 7:00 am. A fire engine will take you to the Clark County Fire Training Center where your experience will begin. From all other destinations, a map is provided in this package.
