TRAIN-THE-TRAINER PROGRAM

The IAFF's 16-hour Instructor Training/Train-the-Trainer (TtT) program provides adult educational methodology to help trainers understand that their principal role is to transform, not to transmit, and that learning requires a change in cognitive structures.

The IAFF understands the philosophy that "telling isn't training," and that "dumping information into learners who do not assimilate all they are told is not instruction." The master instructor must build activities that help learners learn. This new pro-

gram provides master instructors with the basics for transforming what they know into a form that is understandable to their learners.

The Train-the-Trainer provides student instructors with multiple opportunities to practice presentations and small group activities, and receive critiques/analyses of their deliveries. Student instructors will be provided with the tools they need to effectively deliver training for fire fighters and other emergency responders who must operate in a team-based response environment.
