Harvard University trade union program **scholarship**

Two scholarship awards will be made annually for IAFF members to attend the Harvard University Trade Union Program.

Amount of Scholarship:

The Harvard University Trade Union program scholarship has an annual value of \$1,000.00 plus the cost of tuition.

Eligibility:

Those IAFF members eligible include any IAFF member in good standing with an IAFF Local Affiliate.

Basis of Awards:

Applicants must be an active member of the IAFF Local Affiliate and have demonstrated active participation within the IAFF Local Affiliate as an officer, committee member, etc.

Applicants must also prepare a short statement (about 500 words) on one of the following questions:

- (1) Your personal interest in attending the Harvard University Trade Union Program.
- (2) What do you consider to be the major problems facing the labor movement in the United States today?
- (3) What do you consider to be the major problems facing the Fire Fighter in the Labor Union movement today?
