Revised Resolution No. 4 COMMITTEE ASSIGNMENT: Constitution & By-Laws Re: Convention Bid Site Selection Process

WHEREAS, the IAFF biennial convention serves 1 2 as a seminal event for this great union to chart its 3 future course in service to our sister and brother 4 members: and 5 WHEREAS, host cities for IAFF Conventions 6 have become burdened with the responsibilities 7 currently placed on them to generate hundreds of 8 thousands of dollars to defray the costs of hosting; 9 and 10 WHEREAS, this burden discourages locals from 11 bidding on hosting the IAFF Convention; and 12 WHEREAS, Resolution 12 from the 1986 IAFF 13 Convention stated the IAFF shall assume full 14 responsibility for producing the convention; and 15 WHEREAS, in order to select the best possible 16 location for the IAFF Convention, the metrics 17 considered include the availability of thousands of hotel rooms, over 100,000 square feet of meeting 18 19 space, office space, exhibit space, reception space, 20 and other requirements; therefore be it 21 **RESOLVED**, That the IAFF eliminate the 22 convention bid process for convention site cities; and 23 be it further 24 **RESOLVED**, That the IAFF Executive Board 25 present to the delegates assembled at each biennial 26 convention three viable options to host the

27	convention; and be it further
28	RESOLVED, That the delegates assembled shall
29	select the convention site city from those options
30	presented to them; and be it further
31	RESOLVED, That the IAFF assume host
32	responsibilities following the 2028 convention; and
33	be it further
34	RESOLVED , That the General President appoint
35	a committee from the Executive Board to review the
36	entire convention process, including but not limited
37	to timing, dates for events, funding, and any
38	associated policies, and such committee will report to
39	the Executive Board no later than the February 2026
40	Executive Board meeting; and be it further
41	RESOLVED , That Article IV of the IAFF
42	Constitution and By-Laws be amended to read
43	as follows:
44	"Section 1. Time and Place
45	Conventions of this Association shall be regularly
46	scheduled biennially in such city as shall have
47	been selected by a majority of delegates present
48	and voting for Convention Site Cities.
49	The method of selecting the Convention Site City
50	shall be as follows: The IAFF Executive Board
51	shall provide the delegates assembled at
52	convention a list of three (3) candidate cities that
53	meet the criteria for selection as the Convention
54	Site City. The delegates at convention shall vote
55	for their preference among all candidates for the
56	Convention Site City in four years; provided,
57	however, that each delegate can only vote once. If

58 59 60	no candidate for Convention Site City receives a majority vote, the candidate with the fewest votes shall be eliminated, and the process shall be
61	repeated until a candidate receives a majority
62	vote.
63	Should extreme or unusual circumstances be such
64	as to prevent the opening of a convention on the
65	designated date in the city selected by the
66	delegates as its convention site, the Executive
67	Board shall designate a substitute city or
68	substitute date as soon as possible, notification of
69	which shall be promptly sent to all local unions
70	and other subordinate bodies for communication
71	to their delegates."
