11	already begun changing the fire service; and
12	WHEREAS, artificial intelligence and other
13	emerging technologies will continue to change
14	manufacturing, transportation, communications, and

24	the sixteen districts; and be it further
25	RESOLVED, That the Emergency Operations
26	Technology Committee promote the safety and

27	welfare of fire fighters and emergency medical
28	workers through advancements in emerging
29	technologies; and be it further
30	RESOLVED, That per capita be increased by two
31	cents (\$0.02) to cover the meeting costs of this
32	committee.
