Resolution No. 21 COMMITTEE ASSIGNMENT: Health & Safety Re: Female Health & Safety Standing Committee

1	WHEREAS, the primary mission of the
2	International Association of Fire Fighters is to
3	increase the standards of health and safety of our
4	members; and
5	WHEREAS, females in the fire service face
6	health and safety challenges similar to that of men;
7	including increased risk of cancer and reproductive
8	issues; and
9	WHEREAS, females also face unique health and
10	safety challenges, including the design of personal
11	protective equipment, female-specific cancers and
12	exclusion of those cancers from presumptive
13	language, and unique behavioral health challenges;
14	and
15	WHEREAS, there is little research specific to
16	female health and safety in the fire service; and
17	WHEREAS, all of the aforementioned issues
18	contribute to both barriers to recruitment of women
19	in the fire service and increased risk of injury or
20	death of women in the fire service; therefore be it
21	RESOLVED, That the General President appoint
22	a standing committee on Female Health & Safety,
23	comprised of one <u>female</u> member from each of the
	sixteen
24	Districts, and the majority of these members be
	female; and be it further

25	RESOLVED, That this standing committee be
26	charged with developing a comprehensive strategy to
27	address the health and safety challenges faced by
28	females in the fire and emergency medical service;
	and be it further
29	RESOLVED, That per capita be increased by two
30	cents (\$0.02) to cover the meeting costs of this
31	committee.
