COMMITTEE ASSIGNMENT: Health & Safety

Re: Medical Residency Program

1 WHEREAS, the delegates assembled at the 1986
2 IAFF Convention, the 2000 IAFF Convention, and
3 the 2002 IAFF Convention adopted resolutions
4 establishing and funding the IAFF Medical
5 Residency Program with Johns Hopkins University
6 (JHU); and

7 WHEREAS, these three resolutions were adopted
8 to advance fire fighter health and safety by providing
9 funds to establish a relationship with JHU medical
10 residents; and

11 WHEREAS, two cents (\$0.02) was allocated by
12 Resolution 1986 -62, one cent (\$0.01) was allocated
13 by Resolution 2000-81, and one cent (\$0.01) was
14 allocated by Resolution 2002-58, all to support the
15 IAFF Medical Residency program with JHU and
16 host an annual physicians' meeting; and

17 WHEREAS, there are many other medical
18 residency programs and other types of medical
19 training programs at the graduate, post-graduate, and
20 post-doctoral levels that would be beneficial for the
21 IAFF to explore; therefore be it

22 RESOLVED, That the IAFF Medical Residency
23 Program be re-established as a program open to
24 exploring relationships with other medical
25 institutions to increase efficacy, efficiency, and
26 accessibility to other programs that may benefit IAFF

27 members; and be it further
28 RESOLVED, That the four cents (\$0.04)
29 previously allocated to the IAFF Medical Residency
30 Program and annual physicians' meeting be retained
31 for the purpose of re-establishing this program and
32 the annual physicians' meeting.
