## **COMMITTEE ASSIGNMENT: Health & Safety**

Re: National Transportation Safety Board Subject Matter Experts

1	WHEREAS, the National Transportation Safety
2	Board (NTSB) is responsible for the investigation of
3	major incidents or accidents involving aviation, rail,
4	marine, and commercial roadways; and
5	WHEREAS, IAFF members are called to respond
6	to respond and operate to mitigate the hazards
7	present at these incidents, often at great risk to
8	themselves; and
9	WHEREAS, IAFF members have sustained
10	injuries and died in the line-of-duty as a result of
11	their response and operations during these incidents;
12	and
13	WHEREAS, the IAFF has supported the NIOSH
14	Fire Fighter Fatality Investigation Program through
15	investigation participation and support, providing a
16	fire fighter perspective; and
17	WHEREAS, the IAFF has recently supported the
18	NTSB investigation at the train derailment and
19	hazardous materials release in East Palestine, OH;
20	and
21	WHEREAS, the IAFF has been invited by the
22	NTSB to be a party to the investigation of the tragic
23	double line-of-duty deaths at the Grande Costa
24	D'Avoria shipboard fire in Newark, NJ; and
25	WHEREAS, the IAFF has provided valuable

26	insight and perspective related to fire service
27	operations which the NTSB does not currently
28	possess; and
29	WHEREAS, this input has enabled the NTSB to
30	incorporate fire fighter safety and operations
31	considerations into their reports; and
32	WHEREAS, the IAFF believes there is a benefit
33	to increased fire service participation in NTSB
34	investigations; and
35	WHEREAS, subject matter experts (SMEs) can
36	speak the fire fighter language and act as a
37	facilitative interpreter between the parties; therefore
38	be it
39	RESOLVED, That the IAFF propose and support
40	that investigations involving fire service response,
41	fire fighter injuries, or fire fighter fatalities at TSB of
42	Canada and NTSB- governed transportation
43	accidents incorporate the IAFF in their investigation;
44	and be it further
45	RESOLVED, That the IAFF will establish a
46	program to identify and assemble work groups of
47	IAFF SMEs to assist in investigating, reviewing, and
48	providing input on TSB of Canada and NTSB
49	investigations; and be it further
50	RESOLVED, That these SMEs should
51	accompany TSB of Canada and NTSB investigators
52	to the department where the fatality occurred to
53	participate in the investigation and to engage the
54	IAFF local involved in the TSB of Canada and
55	NTSB investigation; and be it further
56	RESOLVED, That the SMEs will participate with

57	the TSB of Canada and NTSB or in the role as a
58	party to the investigation to develop
59	recommendations to the TSB of Canada
60	and NTSB to improve fire fighter operations and
61	safety.
