COMMITTEE ASSIGNMENT: Policy

Re: Discontinuation of Resolution 2002-62 NFPA 1710

1 WHEREAS, at the IAFF 56th Convention in
2 2022, the IAFF Executive Board submitted
3 Resolution No. 3; and

4 WHEREAS, some of these Resolutions were only
5 intended to fund a program’s regular annual costs,
6 while other Resolutions were intended to sustain a
7 program through its fluctuating costs and needs over
8 a number of years; and

9 WHEREAS, the programs receiving per capita
10 allocations were designated to be annual or
11 perpetual based on that intention; and

12 WHEREAS, at the end of each fiscal year,
13 Resolution No. 31 from the 56th Convention
14 stipulated that the General Secretary-Treasurer shall
15 publish a report of all annual fund balances
16 transferred to the Reserve Fund or from the
17 Reserve Fund to an annual or perpetual fund; and

18 WHEREAS, at the 2002 convention, Resolution
19 No. 62 was adopted to fund video ads/PSAs to
20 promote NFPA 1710; and

21 WHEREAS, the IAFF did develop a white board
22 video to promote the benefits of NFPA 1710 which
23 was exceptionally well received and successful; and

24 WHEREAS, over the history of NFPA 1710 there
25 have been changes to the standard and the IAFF has
26 been able to communicate those changes without

27 developing additional video ads/PSAs; and
28 WHEREAS, the office of the General Secretary-
29 Treasurer has identified that the funding from
30 Resolution 2002-62 is not being used for the purpose
31 stated in the original resolution; therefore be it
32 RESOLVED, That the annual funding
33 established by Resolution No. 62 from the 2002
34 IAFF Convention will be discontinued, and per
35 capita reduced by the amount of 1 cent (\$0.01).
