COMMITTEE ASSIGNMENT: Policy

**Re: Updating Resolutions for IAFF Members
Responding to Active Shooter and Opioid
Response**

1 WHEREAS, the IAFF believes that the
2 membership must be adequately trained, equipped,
3 and compensated to respond to active shooter
4 incidents, hostile events, and incidents involving
5 opioids; and

6 WHEREAS, the membership passed Resolution
7 2014-11, “IAFF Members Responding to Active
8 Shooter Events”, and Resolution 2018-12, “Opioid
9 Response”, to address these specific incidents; and

10 WHEREAS, the language of the resolutions is
11 prescriptive with little room for interpretation, may
12 eventually be outdated, and because of both, the
13 IAFF’s ability to provide guidance as tactics,
14 equipment, and medical interventions evolve will be
15 limited and, in some cases, prohibited; and

16 WHEREAS, Resolutions 2014-11 and 2018-12
17 have been enshrined in the Executive Board Policy
18 Book but cannot be amended without the
19 authorization of the membership; therefore be it

20 RESOLVED, That the IAFF Executive Board is
21 granted the ability to update Resolutions 2014-11 and
22 2018-12 as needed to ensure the organization and the
23 membership have contemporary language to use
24 when advocating for training, equipment, safety, and

25 wages as threats evolve
