



IAFF MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (MAP)

WHAT IS MAP?

The Medical Assistance Program (MAP) provides medical expert testimony to support IAFF members – or their surviving family members – during the final appeal of a claim related to an illness or injury caused by firefighting, emergency medical, or rescue service activities.

WHO QUALIFIES?

The member or their Local must have already filed a claim – for workers' compensation, the Public Safety Officers' Benefit (PSOB) program, the Memorial Grant Fund, or pension, disability, or a similar benefit – and that claim must have been denied for medical reasons.

HOW IT WORKS

The IAFF's Chief Medical Officer reviews denied cases and may provide medical expert testimony to assist during the appeal.

PROVEN RESULTS

Since it began, the MAP has helped dozens of members and their families navigate the appeal of their previously denied cases.
