Station Cleaning Checklist

To help minimize the spread of COVID-19, clean all fire stations twice per shift wearing appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) — including surgical mask, impervious gown, gloves and eye protection — with EPA-recommended disinfectants.¹

Kitchen and dining area <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Chairs • Refrigerator • Oven • Microwave • Drawer handles • Coffee pots 		
Bathrooms <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Faucets • Toilet levers • Showers 		
Dorms <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Station bedding (pillows, blankets, covers, mattress pads, etc.) • Side tables • Lamp switches 		
All floors swept and mopped or vacuumed if carpeted		
Laundry machines and extractors (after each use)
