Elizabeth M. Del Re, the Assistant to the General President for Human Relations, Education and Grants Administration, joined the IAFF in 2004 as a Health and Safety Assistant. She was previously a fire fighter/paramedic with the City of Fairfax Fire and Rescue Department and an active member of Fairfax City, VA Local 2702. In addition, she worked as the Director of Department of Defense Training for the University of Maryland, Maryland Fire and Rescue Institute.
