



# Harvard University Trade Union Program **SCHOLARSHIP**



Two scholarships were awarded last year, but due to COVID, attendance was delayed until 2023. Therefore, one scholarship, plus a \$1,000 stipend, will be awarded this year to an IAFF member living in the United States in good standing with their local affiliate. Deadline for applications is **September 19, 2022**.

## **AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP**

The Harvard University Trade Union Program Scholarship covers the cost of tuition plus \$1,000.

## **ELIGIBILITY**

Any IAFF member living in the United States and in good standing with their IAFF local affiliate.

## **CRITERIA**

Applicants must be an active member of their IAFF local affiliate and have demonstrated active participation within their local as an officer, committee member, etc. (*Signature of District Vice President is suggested but not required*)

**Applicants must prepare a short essay of 500 words or more on one of the following questions:**

- (1) What is your personal interest in attending the Harvard University Trade Union Program and how will it benefit you professionally?
- (2) What do you consider to be the major problem(s) facing the professional fire fighter within the labor movement in the United States today?

**Applicants must also include a brief statement of 250 words or more on how they have demonstrated active participation within their local.**
