SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The IAFF is pleased to announce that the 2021 Harvard Trade Union Program (HTUP) will be offered as an online workshop. **Deadline for** applications is December 7, 2020.

Workshop Overview

The workshop is structured to provide four days of consecutive instruction that consists of ten, 90-minute sessions on topics such as: Overview of the Economy; COVID Impact on Workers; COVID and Climate Change; Strategic Planning in the Time of COVID; Pandemic Safety and Health; COVID and Capital Stewardship; Legal Structures in the New Congress and Presidential Term; Labor Movements and Social Justice; Labor Leadership and Diverse Membership and The Pandemic Around the World.

Dates and Times

HTUP is offering the online workshops in two separate four-day deliveries during the months of February and March. The dates for the workshop are February 11-12 and 18-19 or March 11-12 and 18-19. Workshops will be held between 3-8 p.m. (EST.)

Eligibility and Criteria

Any IAFF member living in the United States and Canada that is in good standing with their IAFF local affiliate. IAFF member must be available to accept either week option provided by Harvard for their designated registration and program delivery. **Upon review of the applications, applicants must have the approval of their District Vice President for consideration of the scholarship.**

The IAFF will award <u>two</u> scholarships <u>per district</u>, for a total of <u>32</u> awards, for members to attend the Harvard University Trade Union Program Online Workshop. All applications must be emailed to <u>scholarships@iaff.org</u>.

Applications must be received no later than December 7, 2020.
