Shared experience is powerful. All our facilities foster a therapeutic community of peer support and interaction to augment the effects of clinical programming. At Edgewood in Nanaimo, BC and Gateway in Peterborough, ON, we can additionally accommodate patients in trauma-focused programs separately. These centres offer an exclusive residential setting for military, veterans and first responders that encourages trust and safety with those who possess a shared understanding.

- Dialectical Behavioural Therapy (DBT)
- Acceptance and Commitment Therapy (ACT)
- Motivational Interviewing (MI) for Addiction
- Accelerated Resolution Therapy (ART)
- Prolonged Exposure Therapy (PE)
- Cognitive Processing Therapy (CPT)
- Virtual Reality Enhanced Treatment
- Peer Recovery Groups (12-step recovery and SMART Recovery)
- Safety Planning for Suicide Prevention

We understand the challenging experiences of military, veterans and fire fighters.

OUR PROGRAMS OFFER:

- Treatment exclusively for military service members, veteran or first responders to include police, fire and ambulance personnel
- A personalized approach to treatment for PTSD with or without concurring substance use
- Evidence based individual and group treatment delivered by regulated mental health professionals with specialized trauma and fire service training
- \checkmark Psychiatrists and doctors certified to prescribe medications onsite
- ✓ 24/7 medical support in residential treatment
- Seven-week average length of stay, or nine weeks for patients with co-occurring trauma and substance use
- Integrated care, including yoga, meditation, fitness, nutrition, sleep hygiene, art therapy and access to occupational therapy
- Family support via 2.5 day workshop and ongoing family outreach
- \checkmark Comprehensive discharge and relapse prevention planning
- Ten months of live weekly aftercare group support by virtual recovery tools (Wagon App)
